

HUNTER DIVISIONS

TICKETED WARM UP – Limited to 2 trips in every ring, open to all horses and riders. This class will not be judged.

WALK-TROT – open to all Horses and Riders.

*** POLES HUNTER** – open to all horses and Riders (W/T & canter #52)

***CROSS RAIL HUNTER** - open to all Horses and Riders.

BABY GREEN – (2ft) a horse or pony in its first year of showing.

***BEGINNER RIDER HUNTER** – (2ft) open to riders who have not won over 3 blue ribbons over fences and have not jumped over 3 ft.

MONEY HUNTER STAKES CLASSES – (2ft & 2'6ft) open to all horses and riders, prize money. Payback to six places if entries permit.

LIMIT RIDER HUNTER – (2'6ft) open to all horses and riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons over fences and have not jumped 3ft. or higher.

NOVICE RIDER CHILD/ADULT HUNTER (2'6 – 2'9ft) open to children or adults who have not shown over 3'3 or are not showing in the child/adult hunters at this show.

NON-PRO HUNTER – (2'6 – 2'9ft) juniors or amateur adults.

PRE-GREEN HUNTER – (2'9 – 3ft) open to a horse of any age showing in its first or second year of showing. Not to have shown 3'6 ft or higher.

CHILD/ADULT HUNTER – (2'9 – 3ft) open to juniors or amateur adult who are not showing in the novice child/adult hunter at this show.

JR./A/O HUNTER – Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Junior horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Children's hunters. Fence height 3'6ft.

LOST VALLEY LAKE LEADLINE – open to riders learning to ride. Must be led by a handler, can not cross enter any other classes.

*Management reserves the right to split child/adult if entries permit.
